EARLY-ABSENTEE VOTING IN PERSON. Voters may wish to vote an Early-Absentee ballot in-person at the:

- September 21 – October 2 (Monday-Friday) 8 a.m. – Noon and 1 – 5 p.m.
- October 5 (Monday) 8 a.m. – Noon

ABSENTEE BY-MAIL VOTING. Qualified voters may submit a completed *City of Whittier Absentee By-Mail Ballot Application* to have a ballot mailed to them. **The application deadline** for the October 6, 2020, election is **Tuesday, September 22, 2020**. SPECIAL NEEDS OR ASSISTANCE. If you or someone you know requires special assistance in voting due to disability, please contact the City Clerk at least 24 hours before the time of casting a ballot.

QUALIFICATIONS OF VOTERS. To qualify to vote in the election, you must be:

- Qualified to vote in state elections under AS 15.05.01;
- A resident of the City for 30 calendar days immediately preceding the election;
- Registered to vote in state elections at a residence address within the city at least 30 calendar days before the city election at which the person seeks to vote; and
- Not disqualified to vote under Article V of the Alaska Constitution.

The deadline to qualify to vote in the October 6, 2020, regular election is **Sunday, August 30, 2020**. To register to vote or update your voter registration record, you must complete and sign a *State of Alaska Voter Registration Application*. You may complete the application online with Division of Elections at: voterregistration.alaska.gov or in person at Whittier City Hall Clerk's Office during regular business hours.
