RESOLUTION 2022-020**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
WHITTIER, ALASKA, APPROVING REPAIRS TO LIFT STATION 5
FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000 AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS**

WHEREAS, Since 1996, Lift Station #5's Pump 2 has been pumping sewage for the City of Whittier; and

WHEREAS, Pump 2 has pumped approximately 243 million gallons of sewage and has given the City 4,500 hours of service; and

WHEREAS, the City experienced damage to various areas in Lift Station #5 and as a result, Pump 2 is no longer operational; and

WHEREAS, in the process of examining the failure of Pump 2 the City has identified additional areas in the wet well and control building that require repair; and

WHEREAS, the cost of repairs is estimated to be in the range of \$22,000 to \$25,000 and the 2022 budget did not anticipate an expenditure of this magnitude.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Whittier City Council that repairs to pump 2 in Lift Station 5 are hereby authorized in accordance with the municipal code's emergency purchasing provisions, WMC 3.32.210(C).

Section 1. Funding in the amount of \$25,000 is hereby appropriated from the Water/Wastewater Major Repair and Replacement Fund Reserves account no.75-000-3000 to the Equipment repairs account no. 75-800-7350.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
