

**CITY OF WHITTIER
RESOLUTION #28-2019**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE WHITTIER CITY COUNCIL CERTIFYING THE RESULTS
OF THE OCTOBER 1, 2019, REGULAR ELECTION.**

WHEREAS, the City Clerk and three election officials met as a Canvass Board on October 8, 2019, to judge the validity of absentee by-mail, early-absentee, special needs, and questioned ballots cast by voters in the October 1, 2019, Regular City Election; and

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2019, the Canvass Board opened and tallied the accepted absentee by-mail, early-absentee, special needs, and questioned ballots; and

WHEREAS, the results of the accepted ballots were added to the results of the regular ballots cast by voters at the polls on Election Day; and

WHEREAS, the results compiled by the Canvass Board will be posted as the City of Whittier Official Results of the Regular City Election of October 1, 2019.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the October 1, 2019, Regular City of Whittier Election was held valid to the best of our knowledge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the official results of the October 1, 2019, Regular Election are certified as follows:

1. Thomas M. Wagner was elected to Seat B, a three-year term ending October 2022, having received the greatest number of votes cast for Seat B.
2. Dave Dickason was elected to Seat C, a three-year term ending October 2022, having received the greatest number of votes cast for Seat C.
3. Debra Hicks was elected to Seat G, a three-year term ending October 2022, having received the greatest number of votes cast for Seat G.
