RESOLUTION #21-2020**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITTIER,
ALASKA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A
GRANT AGREEMENT FOR A FY2020 DESIGNATED LEGISLATIVE
GRANT FOR THE PURPOSE OF MITIGATING THE RISK OF COVID-19
ON CRUISE SHIP PASSENGERS, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$291,630, AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS**

WHEREAS, as a coastal Alaskan community serving cruise ships and their passengers in Alaska, the City of Whittier has sustained, and will continue to sustain, substantial impacts associated with the impact of COVID19; and

WHEREAS, the City of Whittier has been awarded a FY2020 Designated Legislative Grant in accordance with AS 37.05.315 Grants to Municipalities, for the purpose of Mitigating the Risk of COVID19 on cruise ship passengers; and


WHEREAS, to accept these funds, the City must execute a grant agreement and provide a detailed project description and proposed timeline to the State, and staff is working with the State to identify eligible means to mitigate the risk of COVID19 on cruise ship passengers; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the community, that the City accept these grant funds to defray costs aimed at mitigating the risk of COVID19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Whittier City Council authorizes the City Manager to: 1) execute any documents necessary to accept and expend funds in the approximate amount of \$291,630 from the State of Alaska as authorized by a FY2020 Designated Legislative Grant; 2) separately track costs related to this program in a Special Revenue Fund; and 3) and to accept and appropriate funds in accordance with the provisions of AS 37.05.315 and the related grant agreement.
