RESOLUTION #24-2020**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE WHITTIER CITY COUNCIL CERTIFYING THE RESULTS  
OF THE OCTOBER 6, 2020, REGULAR ELECTION.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Clerk and three election officials met as a Canvass Board on October 12, 2020, to judge the validity of absentee by-mail, early-absentee, special needs, and questioned ballots cast by voters in the October 6, 2020, Regular City Election; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 12, 2020, the Canvass Board opened and tallied the accepted absentee by-mail, early-absentee, special needs, and questioned ballots; and

**WHEREAS**, the results of the accepted ballots were added to the results of the regular ballots cast by voters at the polls on Election Day; and

**WHEREAS**, the results compiled by the Canvass Board are attached via Canvass Board Certificate as the City of Whittier's Official Results of the Regular City Election of October 6, 2020.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the October 6, 2020, Regular City of Whittier Election was held valid to the best of our knowledge.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the results of the October 6, 2020, Regular Election are certified as follows:


- 1. DAVID PINQUOCH**, was elected to Seat E, a three-year term ending October 2023, having received the greatest number of votes cast for Seat E.
- 2. PETER DENMARK** was elected to Seat F, a three-year term ending October 2023, having received the greatest number of votes cast for Seat F.
- 3. DANIEL BLAIR** was elected to Seat G, a two-year term ending October 2022, having received the greatest number of votes cast for Seat G.
