POSITION SUMMARY: The City of Whittier is hiring 2–3 motivated youth (ages 14–17) to serve as members of the Youth Litter Patrol (YLP) as part of the ALPAR initiative. This temporary summer position offers a great opportunity to earn money, build job skills, and make a difference in the local environment. YLP members work together to collect litter and help beautify streets, parks, trails, and the Head of the Bay area—enhancing the community while learning about environmental responsibility. YLP members will work up to eight hours each week during the summer season.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Pick up litter and properly dispose of waste using provided safety gear and tools.
2. Track and report the number of bags filled each shift.
3. Wear appropriate clothing and follow safety rules at all times.
4. Demonstrate respect for peers, the public, and the environment.
5. Follow directions from the Supervisor and maintain a positive attitude.
6. Separate recyclables (e.g., aluminum, glass) from trash when possible.
7. Accurately complete and sign a timesheet each pay period.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Must be between the ages of 14 and 17.
2. Ability to follow verbal directions and work as part of a team.
3. Commitment to punctuality, safety, and a strong work ethic.
4. Willingness to work outdoors, including in light rain or cool weather.
